Confessions may be heard before the Liturgy or by appointment. On Liturgy days the last confession should begin before 10.45 a.m. to allow the priest to begin the Liturgy on time – please phone if you can to help him plan.

On days marked (generally great feasts, commemorations or meetings) there is a communal meal after the Liturgy. Anyone contributes who wishes (fasting food during fasts), and all are welcome who wish to stay. Any food brought for a meal should be ready to serve and not need preparation in the kitchen. After other services tea, coffee and biscuits are served, or a cake may be shared.
